**ORDER RESTRICTING OUTDOOR BURNING**

**WHEREAS** the Bandera County Commissioners Court has determined that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated area of the county create a public hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** by the Commissioners Court of Bandera County that all outdoor burning is prohibited or restricted in the unincorporated area of the county for 90 days from the date of adoption of this Order, unless the restrictions are terminated earlier based on a determination made by this Court. This Order is adopted pursuant to Local Government Code 352.081 and other applicable statutes. This Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Natural Resources Commission for (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) harvesting of agricultural crops or, (4) burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code, and meet the standards of Section 153.047 Natural Resource Code.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Commissioner Court authorizes the County Judge to temporarily suspend this order as deemed proper, after consulting with the County Fire Marshal. The suspension of this order will terminate immediately by order of the County Judge after consultation with the County Fire Marshal when the conditions creating the public hazard are present again.


In accordance with Local Government Code 352.081(h), a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
