\$50.00 For Non Resident of Bandera County

\$35.00 County Residents, Jet Ski Users, and Park User.

\$20.00 Annual Pass for Senior Citizens of Bandera County (55 Year & Older)

\$25.00 County Residents with Boat for Ramp Use Only.

Please display the Park Guest Pass on the front Windshield of Your Vehicle While Using or returning to the park.

PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No Glass Containers of any Kind.
2. No swimming or parking in the boat launch area. Use care when approaching swimming area by boat.
3. Small BBQ fire are permitted but charcoal should be used and care should be taken as with any fire.
4. No overnight camping.
5. No Loud Music.
6. No firearms or weapons permitted in Park.
7. Please deposit trash in cans or dumpster located in the park.
8. Dogs or other pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
9. Obey No Wake Zones.
